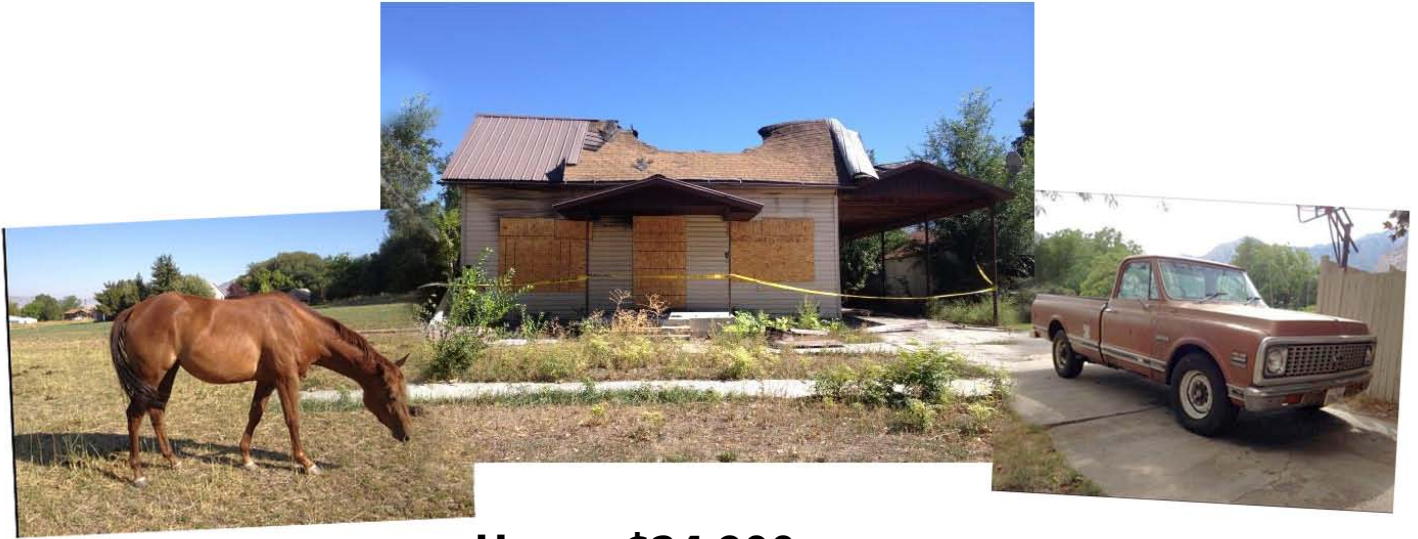


Things You Can Keep, No Matter How Bad You Lose in Court:



Horse: \$500

This is "Klassy," a 2 Year-old Sorrel Filly for sale in Collinston, Utah. They may garnish your wages, but Klassy can weather the storm thanks to Utah's \$1,000 exemption for "animals, books, and musical instruments." That's \$1,000 total, so (bonus) you would still have \$500 for an old piano.

Home: \$24,900

This two-bedroom home is on the market in Tremonton, Utah. It was damaged by a fire, but fits neatly within Utah's exemption of \$30,000 for a home. That's not much compared to other states, but last year it was even lower.

Truck: \$2,500

This is a 1971 Chevrolet C-Series with 77,285 miles on it, listed for sale in Ogden, Utah. Some of the parts are rusted out, but even with some body work and a new set of tires, you should still be covered by Utah's \$3,000 exemption for a car.
